
A by-law to provide for the use of voting and vote-counting equipment

WHEREAS Section 42 of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996 provides that a municipal council may at least sixty days prior to voting day, pass a by-law authorizing the use of voting and vote counting equipment;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton enacts as follows:

1. The use of vote-counting equipment is hereby authorized in respect of the municipal election to be held in 1997 and in subsequent elections.

Read a first, second and third time and passed in open Council this 8th day of September, 1997
