BY-LAW

Number 213-2003

A by-law to amend Animal By-law 7-92, as amended

WHEREAS By-law 7-92 was passed to licence dogs, and to prohibit the running of dogs at large and to carry out the operation of the Brampton Animal Shelter and Pound, and

WHEREAS it is deemed appropriate to further amend that by-law to update the provisions of the Sterilization (spay/neuter) program, and to increase the fees for the adoption of dogs;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That By-law 7-92, as amended, is hereby further amended by deleting Section 21 and substituting therefor the following:

“21. All dogs and cats purchased from the City of Brampton Animal Services shall, if not already done, be spayed or neutered by a veterinarian of the owner’s choice. The spay/neuter surgery must be completed within 42 days of adoption or by the age of five months. If the veterinarian feels the surgery is detrimental to the health of the animal, the Animal Services Section must receive a statement in writing signed by the veterinarian. The City will subsidize the owner by way of a spay/neuter certificate in the amount set out in Schedule 1. The owner will receive the amount of the certificate by way of cheque after returning all the necessary documents.”

2. That By-law 7-92, as amended, is hereby further amended in Schedule I to provide that the Adoption Fee - Dogs Out is \$129.00.
