






I, LEONARD J. MIKULICH, of the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel, MAKE OATH AND SAY:

D. R. Billett, Director of Development Control for the Region, to whom the Region delegated approving authority for street closures, indicated to the City of Brampton that The Regional Municipality of Peel had no objection.
4. The matter of the proposed enactment of this by-law came before City Council at its meeting of the 28th day of September, 1998. No persons applied to be heard in respect of this matter.
