
To establish certain lands as

as parts of public highways;

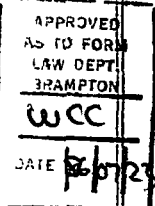
NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of
