Registered Plan 1002


WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to accept and assume certain streets and lands, and to establish other lands, shown on Registered Plan 1002 as public highways;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

Schedule A
