The land situated in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Town of Brampton, County of Peel), being the whole of Block A, Railway Block, according to Registered Plan BR-5.

SECONDLY:

The land situated in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Town of Brampton, County of Peel), being composed of the whole of Block B, Railway Block, according to Registered Plan BR-5.

(to be part of Lynch Street)
