BY-LAW

Number 221-85

To make it lawful for any person to engage in or be present at certain activities on the Lord's Day (Bingo Lottery - Brampton Arts Council)


WHEREAS the Brampton Arts Council proposes to operate a bingo lottery on the dates set out in Schedule A to this by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 1 (1) of the Lord's Day (Ontario) Act (R.S.O 1980, c. 253, as amended) is hereby declared to apply in the City of Brampton between 1:30 o'clock and 5:00 o'clock in the afternoon on the dates set out in Schedule A to this by-law, in respect of the bingo lottery to be conducted by the Brampton Arts Council, at Brampton Bingo Country Project, 291 Rutherford Road South in Brampton.
2. All activities permitted by this by-law shall be conducted in an orderly manner.
