A By-law to authorize the execution of Municipal Access Agreements and amend By-law 191-2011, as amended, to delete the delegation of authority for execution of certain Municipal Access Agreements in the form as approved by Council resolution CW0910-2000 on October 11, 2000

WHEREAS Section 11 of the *Municipal Act 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, permits the council of a municipality to pass by-laws with respect to highways over which it has jurisdiction:


WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton (the "City") has negotiated with various federally regulated telecommunications providers for access to the City's highways for the purposes of installing telecommunications lines and equipment authorized by the *Telecommunications Act*, S.C. 1993, c.38, as amended;

WHEREAS a generic municipal access agreement in the form approved by Council resolution CW0910-2000 by By-law 191-2011, is no longer in use and a new Municipal Access Agreement negotiated with various telecommunications providers has been negotiated;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

 That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute negotiated Municipal Access Agreements and all other documents necessary to give effect to those agreements, based on terms and conditions acceptable to the Commissioner of Works and Transportation, and in a form of agreement acceptable to the City Solicitor; and

2. Schedule "A" of By-law 191-2011 is hereby amended by deleting Item 17.1 as follows: "Municipal Access Agreements with Utility Companies 17.1 The Mayor and the Clerk are authorized to execute municipal access agreements in the form as approved by Council resolution CW0910-2000 on October 11, 2000, including amendments as approved by the City's Legal Services Department and Works & Transportation department, and any other documents necessary to give effect to the municipal access agreement." READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 8th day of August, 2012.
