To amend By-law 151-88 (part of Lot 17, Concession 1, E.H.S., geographic Township of Chinguacousy)

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:


- 1. By-law 151-88, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - (1) by changing, on Sheet 7B of Schedule A thereto, the zoning designation of the land shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from AGRICULTURAL (A) to RESIDENTIAL SINGLE-FAMILY A (3) - SECTION 242 (R1A(3)-SECTION 242), such lands being part of Lot 17, Concession 1, East of Hurontario Street, in the geographic Township of Chinguacousy, now in the City of Brampton.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL, this 23rd day of August 1989.
