SCHEDULE A TO BY-LAW

The land situated in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel, being

FIRSTLY:

Greene Drive, Cupola Court, Charters Road, Chinnock Court, Larkfield Road, Linkdale Road, (now Townsend Gate, pursuant to By-law 301-87, registered as Instrument No. LT835688), Hansen Road and Rutherford Road, as shown on Registered Plan M-26;

SECONDLY:

Abell Drive, Kirkland Road, Ivybridge Drive, Lynwood Court, Hansen Road, Rutherford Road, Bruce Beer Drive and Tye Road (now Archdekin Drive, pursuant to By-law 211-76, registered as Instrument Number 104532) and Blocks XC, XD, XE and XF (one foot reserves) as shown on Registered Plan M-27; Block XC (one foot reserve) to be part of Hansen Road; Block XD (one foot reserve) to be part of Archdekin Drive; Block XE (one foot reserve) to be part of Rutherford Road; and Block XF (one foot reserve) to be part of Bruce Beer Drive.
