BY-LAW

Number 227-2012

To Stop Up and Close and Declare Surplus an un-used street parcel
Being part of the original Torbram Road allowance, north of Steeles Avenue East

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that a portion of the original Torbram Road allowance, having an area of approximately 0.04 acre, located on the west side of Torbram Road, north of Steeles Avenue East, as illustrated on attached Schedule A, be stopped up and closed and declared surplus to the requirements of the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. THAT the portion of the original Torbram Road allowance, having an area of approximately 0.04 acre, located on the west side of Torbram Road, north of Steeles Avenue East, as illustrated on attached Schedule A, be stopped up and closed and declared surplus to the requirements of the City of Brampton.
