BY-LAW

Number 229-88

To amend By-law 139-84, as amended, in respect of parking of trailers and large vehicles, and to repeal and replace By-law 195-84

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. By-law 139-84, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - a) by deleting therefrom in Section 5.0 (DEFINITIONS), the definition of LARGE MOTOR VEHICLE; and
 - b) by adding to Section 5 the following definition of LARGE MOTOR VEHICLE:

"LARGE MOTOR VEHICLE shall mean any motor vehicle having a vehicle weight greater than 2500 kilograms and an overall height greater than 2.3 metres".
2. By-law 195-84 is hereby repealed.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 12th day of October, 1988.
