

## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

## **BY-LAW**

Number	229-95	

To stop up and close and authorize the sale of part of Haggert Avenue

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient that part of Haggert Avenue be stopped up and closed, and sold to the abutting owner as part of a land exchange;

Notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the Brampton Guardian, a newspaper published in the City of Brampton;

The said Corporation has given notice to the Regional Municipality of Peel, pursuant to Section 44 of the Regional Municipalities Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.R.8 as amended and the Regional Municipality of Peel has indicated that it does not object to such stopping up;

The Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The part of Haggert Avenue described in Schedule A hereto is hereby stopped up and closed and declared surplus.
- 2. The sale of the part of Haggert Avenue described in Schedule A hereto to Gummed Papers Limited is hereby authorized. The consideration for the sale shall be the transfer from Gummed Papers Limited to The Corporation of the City of Brampton of the land described as part of Lot 5, Concession 1 West of Hurontario Street designated as Part 6 on Plan 43R-17885 and Part 3 on Plan 43R-20299.
- 3. The transfer to Gummed Papers Limited of the lands described in Schedule A shall be subject to a watermain easement in favour of the Regional Municipality of Peel, if requested by the Region. The transfer of the said watermain easement is hereby authorized.

- 4. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments as may be necessary in the opinion of the City Solicitor to effect the conveyance of the said lands.
- 5. The affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich attached as Schedule B to this by-law forms part of this by-law.
