

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 231-2003

To authorize execution of a licence agreement with 1503574 Ontario Inc.

1503574 Ontario Inc. has applied to the City of Brampton for a licence to utilize part of the untravelled portion of the Torbram Road abutting its property for landscaping, fencing and access purposes.

Section 11(2) of the <u>Municipal Act</u>, 2001 authorizes the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to pass by-laws respecting matters within the highways sphere of jurisdiction that apply to highways within the public highway system of the City of Brampton.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a licence agreement with 1503574 Ontario Inc. in a form approved by the City Solicitor respecting the use of the part of the untravelled portion of Torbram Road illustrated in the sketch attached as Schedule "A" to this by-law.
- 2. The exercise of the natural person powers granted by section 8 of the $\underline{\text{Municipal Act, 2001}}$ is hereby authorized in respect of all matters relating to an arising out of the licence agreement authorized by this by-law.
