BY-LAW

Number _____231 - 2006

To declare surplus to the needs of the City of Brampton certain residential properties

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that those properties identified in Schedule A of this by-law (the "Property Remainders") be declared surplus to the requirements of the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the City purchased certain properties in order to acquire lands for the widening of McLaughlin Road and Chinguacousy Road;

AND WHEREAS the Property Remainders are the portions of those certain properties lying outside of the future widened road limits and the City has agreed to declare the Property Remainders surplus to the requirements of the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the procedures required by section 268 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* have been carried out;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Property Remainders described in Schedule A to this by-law, are hereby declared to be surplus.

READ a **FIRST**, **SECOND** and **THIRD TIME** and **PASSED** in Open Council this 2nd day of August, 2006.
