BY-LAW

Number 234-81

To authorize the payment of line fences awards by the Treasurer

WHEREAS subsection 12(6), of The Line Fences Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 242) permits the council of a local municipality to pass a by-law authorizing the municipal treasurer to make payments directly to an owner of land who is the recipient of an award of the fence-viewers under the provisions of The Line Fences Act;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this by-law,


AWARD shall mean an award made pursuant to section 7 of The Line Fences Act, and


CERTIFICATE shall mean a certificate issued by the fence-viewers in accordance with subsection 12(1), of The Line Fences Act.

2. Where a certificate and an award made in respect of land situate within the City of Brampton, or copies thereof certified by the Clerk in accordance with The Line Fences Act, are deposited with the Clerk, the Treasurer may, upon written application therefor, pay to the owner entitled to receive the amount certified, the amount so certified or a portion thereof, where he is satisfied that the owner is entitled thereto.

3. The Treasurer shall cause the amount paid to the owner under section 1 to be placed upon the collector's roll and to be collected in the same manner as municipal taxes, together with interest thereon accrued from the date of payment at the same rate as the interest added by the City of Brampton under section 412 of the Municipal Act to taxes due and unpaid.
4. Upon making a payment to the owner under section 1, the Treasurer shall forthwith notify the adjoining owner against whom the award is being enforced that the payment has been made.
