



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 235-97

To authorize the execution of an agreement pursuant to Section 30 of the Expropriations Act

The Corporation of the City of Brampton requires the land and temporary easement shown on the sketch attached as Schedule A hereto, and comprising part of Lot 14, Concession 2 East of Hurontario Street in the former Township of Toronto, to permit the reconstruction of the Etobicoke Creek bridge at Kennedy Road South.

The owners of the subject lands have consented to the acquisition of the necessary land and easement by the City, subject to their right to have the compensation to which the owners are entitled determined pursuant to section 30 of the Expropriations Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.E.26, as amended.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute an agreement, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, pursuant to section 30 of the Expropriations Act with Gordon Graham Smith-Fitzpatrick and Kathleen Mavis Smith Fitzpatrick, respecting the acquisition by the City of the land and easement required for the reconstruction of the Etobicoke Creek bridge at Kennedy Road South, as illustrated on Schedule A to this by-law.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are further authorized to execute all documents approved by the City Solicitor that in his opinion are necessary to give effect to the terms of the agreement described in section 1 of this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 15th day of October, 1997.
