To amend By-law 270-2004, as amended

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 270-2004, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - (1) by changing Schedule A thereto, the zoning designation of the lands as shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law:

From:	То:
Industrial 3A - Section	Industrial 3A – Section 2060
335 (M3A-335)	(M3A-2060)

- (2) The lands designated M3A-2060 shall only be used for following purposes:
 - a. The uses permitted in the M3A zone;
 - b. A cemetery (restricted to a crematorium only); and
 - c. A funeral visitation centre.
 - d. A use permitted in 2(a) shall not be permitted in combination with a use in 2(b) or 2(c).
- (3) Shall be subject to the following requirements and restrictions
 - a. A use permitted in 2(a) shall be subject to the provisions of the M3A-335 zone.
 - A cemetery (crematorium only) shall be restricted to a maximum floor area of 225 square metres;
 - c. A minimum 6 metre rear yard setback is required for a cemetery or funeral visitation centre use;
 - d. An accessory dwelling unit shall not be permitted;


