

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number _____ 238-97

To amend By-law 200-82 as amended.

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 200-82, as amended, is hereby further amended:

 by changing on Sheet 34 of Schedule "A" thereto, the zoning designation of the lands shown outlined on Schedule "A" to this bylaw from INDUSTRIAL TWO – SECTION 158 (M2 – SECTION 158) to INDUSTRIAL TWO – SECTION 395 (M2 – SECTION 395) and INDUSTRIAL ONE (M1).

(2) by adding thereto the following sections:

"395 The lands designated M2 – SECTION 395 on Sheet 34 of Schedule A to this by-law:

395.1 shall only be used for:

(a) the purposes permitted by the M2 zone;

- (b) the manufacturing and assembling of motor vehicles; and
- (c) purposes accessory to other permitted purposes.
- 395.2 shall be subject to the following requirements and restrictions:

(a) Minimum Front Yard Depth - 115 metres;

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(b) Minimum Landscaped Open Space:

- (1) 4.5 metres abutting the front lot line, except at approved access locations; and
- (2) 3 metres abutting an M1 zone;
- (c) Outside Storage:
 - (1) the storage of goods and materials in the open need not be associated with a building or another industrial operation;
 - (2) maximum height 6 metres; and
 - (3) no open storage shall be permitted within 3 metres of an M1 zone and 115 metres of the front lot line.
- 395.3 shall also be subject to the requirements and restrictions of the M2 zone and all the general requirements and restrictions of this by-law which are not in conflict with those in subsection 395.2 ."

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL, this 15th day of Oct. 1997.
