BY-LAW

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| To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M-1068 |
| WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the <u>Planning Act</u> , R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City; |
| AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the <u>Planning Act</u> , the council of a municipality may b by-law provide that part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans or parts thereof are designated in the by-law; |
| NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follow |
| 1. Subsection 5 of section 50 of the <u>Planning Act</u> , does not apply to the following lands: |
| City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of: |
| - the whole of Lots 179, 186 and 442, on Registered Plan 43M-1068. |
| This by-law shall come into force upon approval thereof by The Regional Municipality of Peel. READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 27th day of November |
