BY-LAW

Number 239-2012

To authorize the sale of permanent and temporary easements to TransCanada Pipelines Limited over City lands known as Creditview/Sandalwood Park

WHEREAS TransCanada Pipelines Limited is twinning the pipeline that is located in an existing permanent easement across the City lands known as Creditview/Sandalwood Park and they require an additional 10 metre wide permanent easement and temporary working easement and it is deemed in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to execute the agreements and convey the permanent easement, being part of Lots 12 and 13, Concession 4 WHS, City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel, designated as Part 3 on Reference Plan 43R-34579;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the sale of permanent and temporary easement rights to TransCanada Pipelines Limited at fair market value, is hereby authorized and the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute and cause to be registered all documents necessary to effect the said sale by the City of Brampton, on terms and conditions acceptable to the Commissioner, Community Services, and in a form of agreement acceptable to the City Solicitor; and
2. That the net proceeds from the sale be deposited into the net deferred land sales account.
