Number 240-97

A By-law to submit a question to the electors
at the next regular municipal election
(Provincial Pooling Property Taxes)

WHEREAS the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, (S.O. 1996, CH. 32, S. 8), as amended, provides that the Council of a municipality may pass a by-law to submit to its electors a proposed by-law requiring their assent or a question not otherwise authorized by law but within the Council's jurisdiction;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton enacts as follows.

1. There shall be submitted to the electors at the regular municipal election to be held on November 10, 1997, the following question.

Do you agree with the provincial governments proposal to pool Brampton's property taxes with 905 areas to help pay for social service programs like welfare, social housing, child care, public health and ambulance services in Metro Toronto?

2. The Clerk of The Corporation of the City of Brampton shall sum up the number of votes in the affirmative and in the negative on the said question and declare and post the results of the vote pursuant to the requirements of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 15th day of October, 1997.
