A By-law to require an election to be held.

WHEREAS Mrs. Nancy Porteous , with the consent of the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton (herein called the "City") has resigned from her office as a member of the Council of the City and the Council of the City has, by resolution dated the 10th day of September, 1979, declared seat to be vacant;

AND WHEREAS section 45(1) of <u>The Municipal Act</u> provides that where a vacancy occurs in the office of a member of the Council of a local municipality, the Council may, by by-law, require an election to be held to fill the vacancy and where the Council passes such a by-law, the Clerk shall hold a new election to fill the vacancy in accordance with section 90 of <u>The Municipal Elections Act</u>, <u>1972</u>.

The COUNCIL of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

That an election be held to fill the vacancy in the office of the member of the Council for Ward 7 created by the resignation of Mrs. Nancy Porteous

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 10th day of September, 1979.
