	To amend By-law 4-83, as amended, respecting the City of Brampton Safety
	Council

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton enacted By-law 4-83, which established and created terms of reference and composition of the City of Brampton Safety Council;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to recommendation SC080-95, adopted by City Council on October 23, 1995, it is deemed expedient to extend the term of office for Safety Council citizen members to three (3) years, to run concurrently with the term of office for City Council;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 4-83, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:
 - (1) By deleting section 1. a) and substituting therefor the following:
 - "a) Seven persons who are not members of City Council or Regional Council or a local board as defined in Section 1. of the <u>Municipal Affairs Act</u> (R.S.O. 1990 c.M.46), all of whom shall be appointed by Resolution of City Council for a term of office to run concurrently with the term of office for City Council."
 - (2) By deleting section 2. and substituting therefor the following:
 - "2. Each member of the Safety Council, excluding citizen members, shall hold office during the calendar year in which he or she is appointed and until his or her successor is appointed."

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 27th day of November, 1995.
