# BY-LAW

Number 243-2000

To authorize the execution of  
Municipal Access Agreements

**WHEREAS** Paragraph 3 of Section 308 of the *Municipal Act* (R.S.O. 1990, chapter M-45, as amended) permits the council of a municipality to pass a by-law for placing or permitting any person under such conditions as may be agreed upon to place, construct, install, maintain and use objects in, on, under or over sidewalks and highways under its jurisdiction, to permit any person to make, maintain and use areas under and openings in the highways and sidewalks, for prescribing the terms and conditions upon which the same are to be placed, constructed, installed, maintained or used and for making such annual or other charge for the privilege conferred by the by-law as it considers reasonable;

**AND WHEREAS** the City of Brampton has received a large number of requests from telecommunications providers for access to the City's highways, sidewalks and other rights-of-way for the purposes of installing telecommunications lines and equipment as permitted under, *inter alia*, the *Railway Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c. R-3, the *Municipal Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. M-45, the *Bell Canada Act*, S.C. 1987, c. 19, the *Telephone Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. T.4 and the *Telecommunications Act*, S.C. 1993, c.38;


**AND WHEREAS** the City has created a generic form of municipal access agreement to be entered into by said telecommunications providers in order to regulate and control the access to the City's highways, sidewalks and other rights-of-way;

**AND WHEREAS** Council has approved the generic form of municipal access agreement by resolution CW090-2000 passed October 11, 2000;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a) municipal access agreements including amendments as approved by the City's Legal Services Department and Works & Transportation Department and b) any other documents necessary to give effect to this by-law.

**READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED** in Open Council this 30<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2000.
