

BY-LAW

7	Number	246-88	
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To stop up and close and authorize the sale of part of Metzak Drive (formerly Metzak Court)

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that part of Metzak Drive (formerly Metzak Court) on Registered Plan 43M-630 and 43M-631 be stopped up and closed and sold to the owner of abutting lands:

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the Brampton Times, a newspaper published in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the said Corporation has given notice to The Regional Municipality of Peel, pursuant to Section 49 of the Regional Municipality of Peel Act (R.S.O. 1980, c.440, as amended) and The Regional Municipality of Peel has indicated that it does not object to such stopping up;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

The lands situated in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel, being the part of Metzak Drive as named by By-law 78-87, registered as Instrument No. LT752170, formerly Metzak Court according to Registered Plan 43M-630 and 43M-631, and the part of Block 196, Plan 43M-630 established as part of Metzak Drive by By-law 212-87 registered as Instrument No. LT799264, designated as Parts 1, 2 and 3 on Plan 43R-15326.

D.R. Billett, Director of Development Control for the Region, to whom the Region delegated approving authority for street closures, indicated to the City of Brampton that The Regional Municipality of Peel had no objection to the said stopping up of Metzak Drive.
- 4. The matter of the stopping up, closing and sale of Metzak Drive (formerly Metzak Court) designated as Parts 1, 2 and 3 on Plan 43R-15326, came before City Council at its meeting of the 24th day of October, 1988.. No persons applied to be heard in respect of this matter.

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THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON DUBLIC NOTICE OF STREET CLOSING

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton intends to pass a by-law stopping up and closing and authorizing the sale of part of Metzak Drive (formerly Metzak Court) described as follows:

The part of Metzak Drive as named by By-law 78-87 registered as Instrument LT762170, formerly Metzak Court according to Registered Plans 43M-630 and 43M-631, designated as Parts 1, 2 and 3 on Reference Plan 43R-15326.

The part of Metzak Drive to be closed and sold is part of a turning circle which is no longer required, as Metzak Drive is now a through street with the registration of Plan 43M-836.

A print of Plan 43M-15326 may be inspected at the office of the Clerk of the City of Brampton during normal business hours.

The Council or a committee of Council will hear in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, any person who claims that his land will be prejudicially affected by the by-law and who applies to be heard, at a meeting to be held in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Offices, 150 Central Park Drive, Brampton, on the 24th day of October, 1988 at the hour of 7:30 o'clock in the afternoon.
