To amend By-law 151-88, as amended

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 151-88, as amended, is hereby further amended:
  - by changing, on Sheet 62D of Schedule A thereto, the zoning designation of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A to this bylaw from COMMERCIAL TWO - SECTION 500 (C2 - SECTION 500) to SERVICE COMMERCIAL - SECTION 727 (SC - SECTION 727).
  - (2) by adding thereto the following section:
    - "727 The lands designated SC SECTION 727 on Sheet 62D of Schedule A to this by-law:
    - 727.1 shall only be used for the purposes permitted in a SC zone by section 33.1.1.
    - 727.2 shall be subject to the following requirements and restrictions:
      - (1) minimum front yard depth: 15.0 metres;
      - (2) minimum exterior side yard width: 15.0 metres;
      - (3) minimum interior side yard width: 7.5 metres;
      - (4) minimum lot width: 55.0 metres;
      - (5) minimum lot area: 1.0 hectare;
      - (6) a minimum 3.0 metre wide landscaped open space strip shall be provided abutting a street except at

driveway locations;

- (7) no outside storage or display of goods shall be permitted;
- (8) all garbage and refuse containers shall be enclosed;
- (9) all garbage and refuse containers for a restaurant shall be located within a climate controlled area within a building; and,
- (10) an amusement arcade, an adult entertainment parlour, an adult videotape store or a billiard hall shall not be permitted.
- 727.3 shall also be subject to the requirements and restrictions relating to the SC zone and all the general provisions of this by-law which are not in conflict with those set out in section 727.2."



- By-law 225-94 was passed by the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton at its meeting on the 24th day of October, 1994, to adopt Amendment Number 254 and 254A to the 1984 Official Plan of the City of Brampton Planning Area.
- 3. The Ministry of Municipal Affairs approved the aforementioned Amendment on the 15th day of December, 1994.
- 2. By-law 246-94 was passed by the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton at its meeting held on the 28th day of November, 1994.
