To amend By-law 200-82 (part of Lot 5, Concession 1, E.H.S. in the geographic Township of Chinguacousy)

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 200-82, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - (1) by changing, on Sheet 29 of Schedule A thereto, the zoning designation of the land shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from RESIDENTIAL SINGLE-FAMILY B (R1B) and RESIDENTIAL SINGLE-FAMILY B-SECTION 287 (R1B-SECTION 287) to INSTITUTIONAL TWO-SECTION 345 (I2-SECTION 345), such lands being part of Lot 5, Concession 1, East of Hurontario Street, in the geographic Township of Chinguacousy, now in the City of Brampton.
 - (2) by adding thereto as SCHEDULE C-SECTION 345, Schedule B to this by-law.
 - (3) by adding to section 3.2 thereof as a plan to be included in Schedule C the following:

"Schedule C - Section 345"

- (4) by adding thereto the following section:
 - "345 The lands designated I2-SECTION 345 on Sheet 29 of Schedule A to this by-law;
 - 345.1 shall only be used for the following purposes:
 - (1) a parking lot only in conjunction with a hospital purpose
 - (2) purposes accessory to the other permitted purpose

- 345.2 shall be subject to the following requirements and restrictions:
 - (1) Landscaped open space shall be provided and maintained in the locations shown as LANDSCAPED OPEN SPACE on SCHEDULE C-SECTION 345.
- 345.3 shall also be subject to the requirements and restrictions relating to the I2 zone and all general provisions of this by-law which are not in conflict with the ones set out in section 345.2."



PART LOT 5, CON. I, E.H.S. (CHING.) BY-LAW 200-82 SCHEDULE A





DECLARATION

I, KATHRYN ZAMMIT, of the City of Brampton, in the Region of Peel, DO SOLEMNLY DECLARE THAT:

- 1. I am the Deputy Clerk of The Corporation of the City of Brampton and as such have knowledge of the matters herein declared.
- 2. By-law 246-90 which adopted Official Plan Amendment Number 191 was passed by the Council of the Corporation of Brampton at its meeting held on November 12th, 1990, and approved by the Ministry of Municipal Affairs on April 8th, 1991.
- 3. By-law 247-90 to amend Zoning By-law 200-82 (geographic Township of Chinguacousy) was passed by Council of the Corporation of Brampton at its meeting held on November 12th, 1991.
- 4. Written notice of By-law 247-90 as required by section 34 (17) of the <u>Planning Act, 1983</u> was given on November 22nd, 1990, in the manner and in the form and to the persons and agencies prescribed by the <u>Planning Act, 1983</u>, the last day for appeal being December 12th, 1990.
- 5. An appeal under section 34 (18) of the Planning Act, 1983 had been filed on or before the last day for appeal. The Board orders that the appeal against By-law 247-90 is dismissed. Board Order R 910012.
