To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M-1691
EREAS subsection 50(5) of the <i>Planning Act</i> , R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed pa
ontrol on all lands within registered plans within the City;
<b>WHEREAS</b> , pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the <i>Planning Act</i> , the Council of icipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the <i>Planning Act</i> does not apply within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in them;
WHEREAS, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection of the <i>Planning</i> Act, on the lands described below, for the purpose of creating intended the easements for single-detached residential dwellings, is to the satisfaction of the of Brampton;
W THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS ALOWS:
THAT subsection 50(5) of the <i>Planning Act</i> does not apply to the following lands:
City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:
The whole of Lots 2, 3, 4, 5, and Blocks 692, 693, 694, 695, 696, 697, 699, 700 and 702 on Registered Plan 43M-1691;
THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the <i>Planning Act</i> , this by-law shall expire on August 2, 2009 at the end of the business day
