Lots 13 and 14, Concession 2, E.H.S., in the geographic Township of Toronto)

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 139-84, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - (1) by changing, on Sheet 8 of Schedule A thereto, the zoning designation of the land shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from AGRICULTURAL (A) to OPEN SPACE SECTION 680 (OS-SECTION 680).
 - (2) by adding thereto the following section:
 - "680 The lands designated OS-SECTION 680 on Sheet 8 of Schedule A to this by-law.
 - shall only be used for the following purposes:
 - (1) an indoor and outdoor recreation facility;
 - (2) any conservation area or purpose, and
 - (3) purposes accessory to other permitted purposes.
 - shall be subject to the following requirements and restriction:
 - (1) maximum lot coverage 10 per cent;

(2) maximum front yard depth, rear yard
 depth and sideyard width - 30
 metres.

shall also be subject to the requirements and restrictions relating to the OS zone and all the general provisions of this by-law which are not in conflict with the ones set out in section 680.2".


READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL, this 24th day of October 1988.
