## AMENDMENT NUMBER OP93-<u>59</u> TO THE OFFICIAL PLAN OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON PLANNING AREA

#### 1.0 Purpose:

#### 3.0 Amendment and Policies Relative Thereto:


The document known as the Official Plan of the City of Brampton Planning Area is hereby amended:
