# BY-LAW

Number 249-81

To amend By-law 62-81  
(the procedural by-law)

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton  
HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. By-law 62-81 is hereby amended by deleting subsection 8.1(6) and substituting therefor the following:

"8.1 (6) Notwithstanding the previous subsections,  
the Clerk or his staff may


(a) appoint a different time of commencement for a meeting of a standing committee than the one required by this section, if and when the need arises,

(b) move the time of the commencement of a meeting of any standing committee ahead of its appointed time of commencement, but only if the delegations listed in the agenda for that meeting, and all members of that committee, other than the ones who have notified the Clerk of their intention not to attend, are present, and

(c) may delay the time of the commencement of a meeting of any standing committee beyond its appointed time of commencement if the preceding meeting of another standing committee is continuing. "
