

BY-LAW

Number	250-89	
To amend	By-law	861

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 861, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - (1) by deleting therefrom, in its entirety, section 22.5 and substituting therefor the following:
 - "5. (a) Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable:
 - (1) on a first conviction to a fine of not more than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00), exclusive of costs; and
 - (2) on a subsequent conviction to a fine of not more than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) for each day or part thereof upon which the contravention has continued after the day on which the person was first convicted, exclusive of costs.
 - (b) Every corporation that contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable:

- (1) on a first conviction to a fine of not more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00), exclusive of costs; and
- (2) on a subsequent conviction to a fine of not more than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) for each day or part thereof upon which the contravention has continued after the day on which the corporation was first convicted, exclusive of costs.
- (c) Where a conviction is entered under subsections (a) or (b) of this section, in addition to any other remedy or any penalty provided by law, the court in which the conviction has been entered, and any court of competent jurisdiction thereafter, may make an order prohibiting the continuation or repetition of the offence by the person or corporation convicted."

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL, this 25th day of September 1989.
