BY-LAW

Number 250-95

To amend by-law 108-91 which by-law requires the installation of smoke alarms in residential occupancies

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

By-law 108-91 is hereby amended as follows:

- (1) Section 3 be renumbered as 3(a) and the following added as section 3(b):
 - 3(b) Every occupant of a residential occupancy shall install or cause to be installed one or more smoke alarms at each storey of a dwelling unit, including the basement, in accordance with sections 5 and 6.
- (2) Section 4 be renumbered as 4(a) and the words "during occupancy" be deleted.
- (3) Section 4A. be renumbered as 4(b) and the words "during occupancy" be deleted.
- (4) All references in the by-law to the "Fire Department" be amended to "Fire and Emergency Services".
