# BY-LAW

Number 253-96

To authorize the City Solicitor  
to make applications under  
the Municipal Tax Sales Act

Section 10(5) of the Municipal Tax Sales Act R.S.O. 1990, c.M. 60 as amended, provides that under certain circumstances, the proceeds of a tax sale minus the cancellation price which have been paid into the Ontario Court (General Division) by the City Treasurer are deemed to be forfeited to the municipality and the municipality may apply for payment out of court of the amount that was paid in.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The City Solicitor is hereby authorized to apply, on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton, to the Ontario Court (General Division) for payment out of court of any amounts of money deemed to be forfeited to The Corporation of the City of Brampton pursuant to section 10(5) of the Municipal Tax Sales Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.M.60, as amended.
2. The City Treasurer is hereby directed to pay any money received pursuant to an application referred to in section 1 of this by-law, into the general funds of The Corporation of the City of Brampton, in accordance with section 10(6) of the Municipal Tax Sales Act.
