AND WHEREAS reference to part of Lot 1, Plan BR-3 was inadvertently omitted from Schedule A to By-law 244-91;

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

 By-law 244-91 is hereby amended by deleting Schedule A and replacing it with Schedule A to this By-law.
