

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW NUMBER 257-75

Being a By-law to stop up and close and authorize the sale of part of Ashford Court, and Skegby Road.


WHEREAS the City of Brampton has assumed the said streets as public highways, and;


WHEREAS, because of the nature of the development on the lands abutting, the City of Brampton now deems it desirable that certain parts of Ashford Court and Skegby Road be stopped up, closed, and sold to the abutting owners;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That the parts of Ashford Court and Skegby Road more particularly described in Schedule "A" annexed to this By-law be and the same are hereby stopped up and closed.
2. That the sale of the lands stopped up and closed by paragraph 1 of this By-law be and the same are hereby authorized for the sum of \$2.00
3. That the said lands stopped up and closed by paragraph 1 of this By-law be offered first to the abutting owners.
4. This By-law does not take effect until approved by the Ministry of Housing and until a copy certified by the Clerk has been registered in the appropriate Registry Office.


