To amend By-law 93-93, STOP SIGNS, THROUGH HIGHWAYS

The council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 93-93, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

(1) by adding to Schedule IV thereto the following items:

STOP SIGNS

INTERSECTION

COLUMN 2
FACING TRAFFIC

Black Forest Drive and Sprucelands Avenue/Winterberry Gate	Southbound on Sprucelands Avenue
Black Forest Drive and Sprucelands Avenue/Winterberry Gate	Northbound on Winterberry Gate
Black Forest Drive and Sprucelands Avenue/Winterberry Gate	Eastbound on Black Forest Drive
Black Forest Drive and Sprucelands Avenue/Winterberry Gate	Westbound on Black Forest Drive

(2) by deleting from Schedule III thereto the following items:

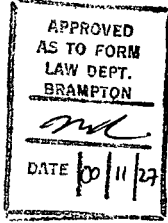



2. Section 1, subsections (1), (2), (3) of this by-law shall not come into force until approved by the council of the Regional Municipality of Peel.


