A By-law to amend By-law 261-93 (To prohibit and regulate the keeping of animals other than dogs)

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. By-law 261-93, the By-law to prohibit and regulate the keeping of animals other than dogs, is hereby amended as follows:
 - (1) In section 1, by deleting the definition of "animal" and substituting therefore the following:

"animal" means all live non-human species; and shall include birds, reptiles, fish, arachnids, and invertebrates, but shall not include a dog.
