To amend By-law 861 of the Former Township of Chinguacousy, now in the City of Brampton (Part of Lot 6, Concession 5, East of Hurontario Street).

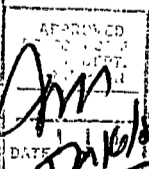
The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 861, as amended, and as specifically amended by By-law 314-81, is hereby further amended:

- (1) by deleting clause (10) of section 323.1.1 and by renumbering clauses 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28 and 29 to 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27 and 28 respectively, and
- (2) by deleting the definitions of "restaurant, dining-room" and "restaurant, mixed service" in section 323.2.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and Passed in Open Council.


