A By-law to authorize a capital expenditure in the amount of \$50,000.00 for the acquisition of certain lands

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton shall undertake the acquisition of those lands set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto, as a capital expenditure at a total estimated cost of \$50,000.00.
- authorized in the name of and on behalf of the
 Corporation to borrow from time to time by way of
 promissory note from the Royal Bank of Canada,
 I Main Street North, Brampton, a sum or sums not
 exceeding in the aggregate \$50,000.00 for the
 aforementioned purpose and to give on behalf of the
 Corporation to the Royal Bank of Canada a promissory
 note or notes sealed with the Corporate Seal and
 signed by the Mayor and the Treasurer for the money
 so borrowed with interest which may be paid in
 advance or otherwise.

- 2. Harold Street at Elizabeth Street daylighting triangles (two corners)
- McMurchy Avenue, daylighting triangles at the following intersections:

 Queen Street, south/west and south/east corners

 Jessie Street, all four corners

 Royce Avenue, south/west and north/west corners

 Frederick Street, north/east corner

 Harold Street, north/east and south/west corners
