



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 265-2004

To authorize the execution of a Municipal
Access Agreement with Brampton
Cogeneration Inc.

WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton is the owner of the lands constituting part of Bramalea Road, and described generally as Part of Lots 13 and 14, between Concessions 4 and 5, E.H.S., in the City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, in the City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel;

AND WHEREAS Brampton Cogeneration Inc. is the owner of an incineration plant at 7656 Bramalea Road, and it wishes to run a steam pipeline beneath Bramalea Road to the Norampac Inc. packaging plant at 7447 Bramalea Road, in Mississauga, for the purpose of providing steam to the packaging plant;


AND WHEREAS to facilitate the construction of the pipeline along Bramalea Road, the Legal Services Department recommends the Corporation of the City of Brampton enter into a Municipal Access Agreement with Brampton Cogeneration Inc., which will specify the terms of the use of the City's land for the pipeline, and through which Brampton Cogeneration Inc. will pay fair market value for the use of the land;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton enacts as follows:

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a Municipal Access Agreement on behalf of the Corporation of the City of Brampton with Brampton Cogeneration Inc., in a form approved by the City Solicitor, regarding the location, construction and maintenance of a steam pipeline beneath the portion of the Bramalea Road road allowance generally located in Part of Lots 13 and 14, between Concessions 4 and 5, E.H.S., in the City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, but to be specified by reference plan, for the purpose of the supply of steam by Brampton Cogeneration Inc. to the Norampac Inc. packaging plant.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 13th day of September, 2004.
