WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton desires to proceed with the construction of a grade separation of Centre Street and the Canadian National Railway, Halton Subdivision Mileage 14.78;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with the regulations of the Government of Canada respecting grants, applications must be made by a province, or by a municipality if the province so confers its authority;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with the requirements of the Ministry of Transportation and Communications, a municipality must pass a by-law of the Corporation requesting the authority of the Province to act on behalf of the Province in applying to the Canadian Transportation Commission for a special grant under the Urban Transportation Assistance Program;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That The Corporation of the City of Brampton request the authority of the Province of Ontario to act on behalf of the Province of Ontario to make application to the Canadian Transportation Commission for a special grant under section 16, part II of the Railway Relocation and

Crossing Act for construction of the proposed grade separation of Centre Street and the Canadian National Railway, Halton Subdivision Mileage 14.78.
