	REAS subsection 50(5) of the <i>Planning Act</i> , R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has sed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;
munic apply	WHEREAS , pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the <i>Planning Act</i> , the Council of a cipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the <i>Planning Act</i> does not to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are nated in the by-law;
AND WHEREAS , the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the Planning Act, on the lands described below, for the purpose of creating blocks and servicing easements to facilitate industrial uses on Blocks 1 to 5, inclusive, 7, 9, 20 and 21, and part of Block 6, is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;	
NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:	
1.	THAT subsection 50(5) of the <i>Planning Act</i> does not apply to the following lands:
