To change the name of Bradgate Court (Plan 43M-643)

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Brampton deems it expedient to change the name of Bradgate Court;

AS WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four successive weeks in The Brampton Guardian, a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Brampton;

AS WHEREAS the council has heard all persons who claimed that they would be adversely affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The name of the street shown as "Bradgate Court" on registered Plan 43M-643, which is described in Schedule A attached hereto, is changed to "Van der Graaf Court".
- 2. The affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich attached as Schedule B hereto shall form part of this by-law.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in Open Council this 14th day of December, 1998.
