# BY-LAW

Number 273-80

A by-law to amend By-law 33-79  
(traffic by-law)

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton  
HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. By-law 33-79, as amended, is hereby further amended:

(1) by deleting from section (1) of PART 1 - INTERPRETATION  
the definition of "MOTOR VEHICLE", and substituting  
therefor the following:

"MOTOR VEHICLE" includes an automobile, truck, bus,  
self-propelled mobile home, motorcycle, motor-  
assisted bicycle, and any other vehicle propelled  
or driven otherwise than by muscular power, but  
does not include the cars of electric or steam  
railways, or motor vehicles running only upon  
rails, or a motorized snow vehicle, traction  
engine, farm tractor, self-propelled implement  
of husbandry or road-building machine within the  
meaning of The Highway Traffic Act."

(2) by adding to section (1) of PART 1 - INTERPRETATION  
the following definitions:

' "HEAVY MOTOR VEHICLE" shall mean any motor  
vehicle having a vehicle weight in excess  
of 2300 kilograms.

"VEHICLE WEIGHT" shall mean the weight of the  
vehicle itself, as set out in the manufacturer's  
specifications. '


(3) by adding to PART 4 - GENERAL STOPPING AND PARKING REGULATIONS the following section:

"(5) HEAVY MOTOR VEHICLES:

(i) A person shall not park a heavy motor vehicle or a truck trailer on any street in any Residential zone, unless it is at the time being used to make a delivery or to provide a service."

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 15th day of October, 1980.
