WHEREAS the lands described in Schedule A hereto are no longer required for municipal purposes;



NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The transfer of the lands described in Schedule A to this by-law from the City to Bramalea Limited, in exchange for a transfer from Bramalea Limited of the lands described in Schedule B to this by-law, is hereby authorized.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents approved by the City Solicitor which are necessary to complete the said exchange of lands.
