
A By-law to declare surplus
Part of Lot 5, Concession 4 East of Hurontario Street, and to
authorize the execution of an Agreement of Purchase and Sale with
The Regional Municipality of Peel

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS
FOLLOWS:

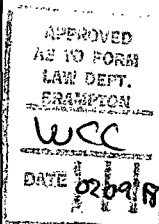
1. The lands described in Schedule "A" to this By-law are hereby declared to be surplus.
2. The sale of the lands described in Schedule "A" to this By-law to The Regional Municipality of Peel at a price of \$1,750,000.000, subject to the usual adjustments, is hereby authorized.
3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute an Agreement of Purchase and Sale between The Corporation of the City of Brampton and The Regional Municipality of Peel in a form approved by the City Solicitor, as well as all other documents that in the opinion of the City Solicitor are necessary to effect the transfer of the said lands.
