



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 276-88

Being a By-law to enlarge a designated improvement area and repeal By-law 220-76

WHEREAS Section 217 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, c. 302, provides that the Council of a local municipality may pass By-laws designating an area as an improvement area;

AND WHEREAS the Council has passed By-law 220-76 designating an improvement area and now intends to increase the size of that improvement area;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a By-law increasing the size of a previously designated improvement area has been given as prescribed by the said Act and no petition objecting to the passing of the By-law has been received within the time limited therefor;


THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. The area comprised of the land, the boundaries of which are shown on the plan annexed hereto and marked as Schedule "A" to this By-law, and forms part of this By-law, is designated as an improvement area within the meaning of Section 217 of The Municipal Act.
2. The affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich attached as Schedule "B" to this By-law forms part of this By-law.
3. By-law 220-76 is hereby repealed effective the 31st day of December, 1988.
4. This By-law shall come into effect on the 1st day of January, 1989.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and Passed in OPEN COUNCIL this 28th day of November, 1988.



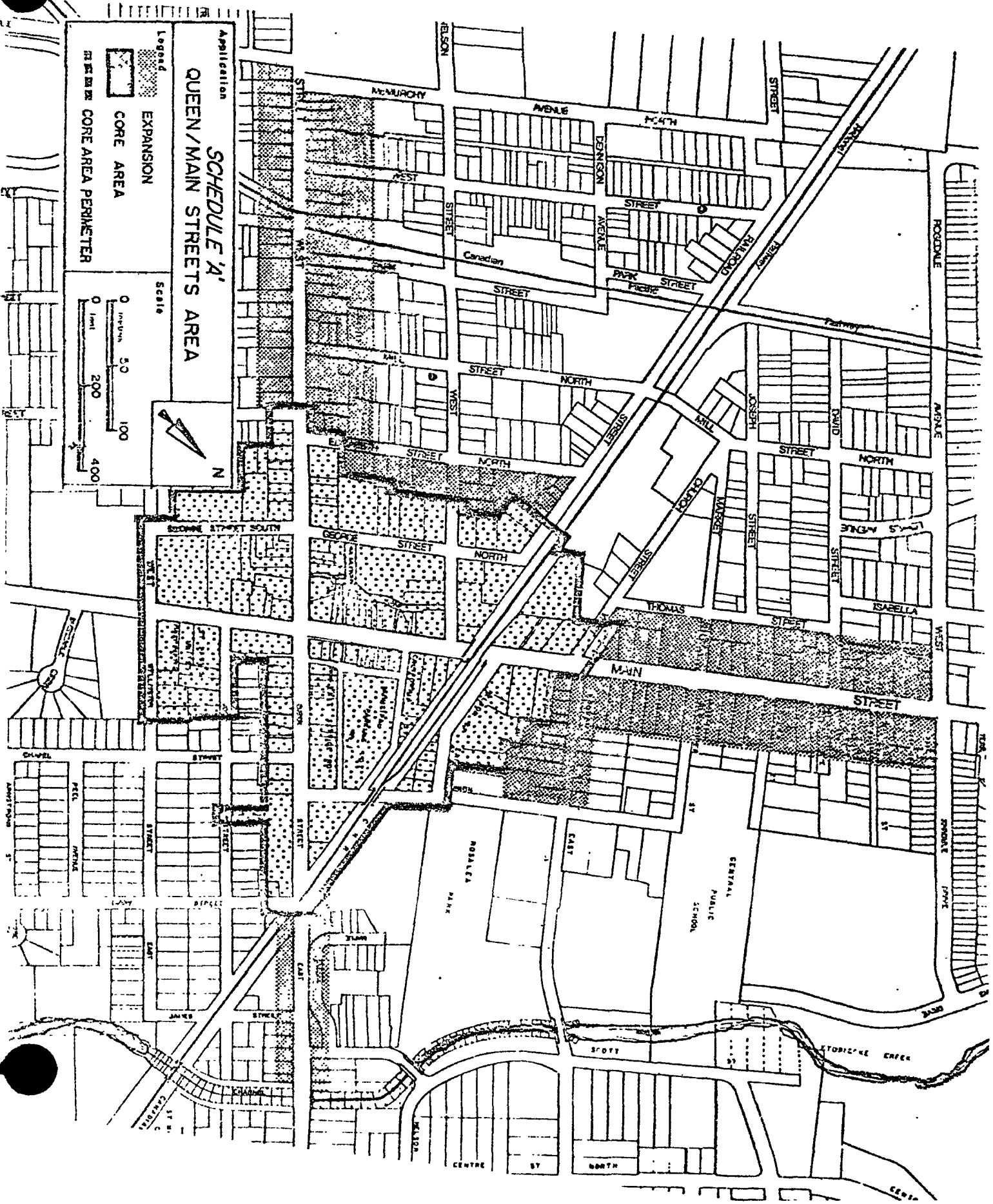

SCHEDULE "B" to By-law 220-76
Affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich

I, LEONARD J. MIKULICH, of the City of Brampton,
in the Regional Municipality of Peel, MAKE OATH AND SAY:

1. I am employed as Clerk and Director of Administration for The Corporation of the City of Brampton and as such, I have knowledge of the facts herein contained.
