BY-LAW

Number 277-2014

To authorize the execution of agreements
To Accept Donations of Land from Private Landowners
As Part of the Greenland Securement Program

Section 6 of the *Municipal Act 2001* authorizes the Council of every corporation to pass a by-law for acquiring or expropriating any land required for the purposes of the corporation. The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is necessary and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to acquire environmentally significant property in fee simple or easement interest for greenland securement purposes.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute agreements with private property owners in Brampton that will effect the gratuitous transfer of fee simple or permanent easement rights to the City, of environmentally sensitive property, as part of the Brampton Greenland Securement Program, on terms and conditions acceptable to the Chief Planning and Infrastructure Services Officer, and in a form of agreement acceptable to the City Solicitor.
